



BSIS FIREARM PERMIT - ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS FOR PROOF OF UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP OR PERMANENT LEGAL ALIEN STATUS

STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP OR LEGAL RESIDENCY PRIOR TO COURSE PARTICIPATION. THESE DOCUMENTS ARE ACCEPTABLE EVIDENCE OF UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP OR PERMANENT RESIDENCE:

1. Birth Certificate showing birth in the United States, American Samoa, District of Columbia, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, Swains Island, or United States Virgin Islands.
2. United States Passport (unexpired).
3. United States Military ID card.
4. Military Discharge Report of Separation (DD-214).
5. Alien Registration Receipt Card [green card] (INS Form I-151 or AR-3a; issued by INS prior to June 1978). This card must contain a photograph of the bearer.
6. Permanent Resident Card [green card] (INS Form I-551, a revised edition of INS Form I-151). This card must contain a photograph of the bearer.
7. Certificate of Naturalization (INS Form N-550 or N-570). This certificate must contain a photograph of the bearer with a dry seal over the photograph. Firearm Training Manual 22
8. United States Citizen Identification Card (INS Form I-197). INS no longer issues these cards, however, once issued, they do not expire). Must contain photo & physical description.
9. Identification Card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (INS Form I-179). INS stopped issuing this card after 1977; however, once issued, they do not expire.
10. Certificate of United States Citizenship (INS Form N-560 or N-561).
11. Certificate of Birth abroad issued by the Department of State (Form FS-545 or form DS-1350).
12. Native American Tribal documents.
13. Permit to Reenter the United States (INS Form I-327). Refugee or parolee documents only if accompanied by INS Form I-151, AR-3a, or I-551.

THESE DOCUMENTS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE AS EVIDENCE OF UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP OR PERMANENT RESIDENCE:

1. Driver's License / State Identification Card.
2. Social Security Card.
3. School / Work Identification Card.
4. Employment Authorization Card (INS Form I-688A).
5. Refugee or parolee documents unless accompanied by INS Form I-151, AR-3a, or I-151. Firearm Training Manual 23
6. Employment Eligibility Verification (INS Form I-9).
7. Foreign Passport.
8. Voter Registration.
9. Hospital Record.
10. Visas.
11. Arrival/Departure Record (INS Form I-94).
12. Temporary Resident Card (INS Form I-688).

NOTE: INSTRUCTORS MAY ACCEPT TEMPORARY RESIDENT CARD (INS FORM I-688) IF THE REVERSE SIDE OF THE CARD DISPLAYS A STICKER ISSUED BY THE IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION SERVICE EVIDENCING TEMPORARY PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP OR PERMANENT RESIDENCE. THE STICKER BEARS THE SEAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.
